

Street Parking Information for the City of Los Angeles

Parking limits for 7th Street: No Stopping 7-9am and 3-7pm; Except Sunday
1 Hour Parking 9am-3pm; Except Sunday

Parking limits for Spring Street: No Stopping 7-9am and 4-6pm; Except Saturday & Sunday
1 Hour Parking 9am-4pm; Except Sunday

Parking meters and No Stopping time periods do not apply on Sundays or recognized holidays such as New Year's, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

If a parking meter is broken, you may legally park at that meter.
To report a broken meter, call 1-877-215-3958

A vehicle may be legally parked in the 7th Street Yellow Curb Zone from 7pm to 7am and may be parked for up to 5 minutes from 9am to 3pm, if actively loading or unloading.

Should your car be towed, call LA DOT (24 hours) at 1-213-485-4184 and then press "2".
You will be asked for your license plate number.

LA DOT website excerpt:

Yellow curb zones are for commercial loading and are installed in commercial districts where there is a compelling and recurrent need to reserve curb space for loading freight and bulky items.
The zones may be used when actively loading or unloading freight, but in no case longer than 30 minutes. They may also be used when actively loading or unloading passengers and their personal baggage, but in no case longer than 5 minutes.
In the City of Los Angeles yellow curb zones are effective 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday (but not on Sunday).

LA Municipal Code excerpt:

SEC. 80.60. EFFECT OF PERMISSION TO LOAD OR UNLOAD.

(a) Permission herein granted to stop or stand a vehicle for purposes of loading and unloading of materials shall apply only to commercial vehicles and shall not extend beyond the time necessary therefor, and in no event for more than thirty (30) minutes, except as provided in Section [88.01.1](#) of this chapter. **(Amended by Ord. No. 170,019, Eff. 10/21/94.)**

(b) The loading or unloading of materials shall apply only to commercial deliveries and to the delivery or pickup of express and parcel post packages and United States mail.

(c) Permission herein granted to stand or park for purposes of loading or unloading passengers shall include the loading or unloading of personal baggage, but shall not extend beyond the time necessary therefor, and in no event for more than five (5) minutes. **(Amended by Ord. No. 168,058, Eff. 8/8/92.)**

(d) Within the total time limits above specified the provisions of this section shall be enforced so as to accommodate necessary and reasonable loading or unloading but without permitting abuse of the privileges hereby granted.

SEC. 80.61. STANDING IN ANY ALLEY.

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of persons or materials in any alley.
